Our Mission:

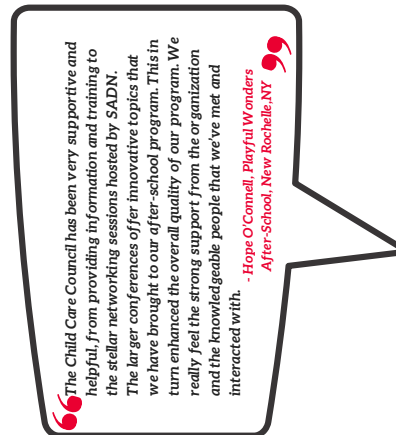
We are a 501c3 not-for-profit organization that champions the healthy development of children, families and our community by promoting quality early care and education.
