OCFS regulations require programs, at the time of a child admission, to give parents a written policy statement that includes “the policies of the child day care center regarding admission and disenrollment policies.” Whether because of non-payment, not following policies, a child’s behavior, or other reasons, terminating a contract is never easy. We will look at what a disenrollment policy should include, what your policy should say, and how to write a disenrollment notice. We will also discuss ways to avoid having to use your policy. ***Please have your enrollment/disenrollment policy with you for the training.***
